2 substances listed in s. 893.03(3)(d). The reasonable-suspicion
3 drug testing authorized by this subsection shall be conducted
4 in a manner that is consistent with s. 112.0455, but may also
5 include testing upon reasonable suspicion based on violent
6 acts or violent behavior of an employee who is on or off duty.
7 The department shall adopt rules pursuant to ss. 120.536(1)
8 and 120.54 which are necessary to administer this subsection.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.

13 Senate Bill 1736

14 Provides that the Department of Corrections may develop a
15 program for the reasonable-suspicion drug testing of employees
16 who are in safety-sensitive and high risk positions for
17 anabolic steroids. Testing must be done in a manner consistent
18 with s. 112.0455, F.S., but may also be based on violent acts
19 or violent behavior when an employee is on or off duty.
