12	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

14	Section 1. Section 14.055, Florida Statutes, is
15	amended to read:
16	14.055 Succession to office of GovernorUpon vacancy
17	in the office of Governor, the Lieutenant Governor shall
18	become Governor. Upon vacancy in the office of Lieutenant
19	Governor, the Governor shall appoint a successor who shall
20	serve for the remainder of the term, provided that if after
21	<u>the</u> <del>such</del> appointment a vacancy <u>occurs</u> <del>shall occur</del> in the
22	office of Governor with more than 28 months remaining in the
23	term, <del>then</del> at the next statewide general election the electors
24	shall choose a Governor and Lieutenant Governor to fill the
25	remainder of the term in the manner provided in s. 5, Art. IV
26	of the State Constitution. Upon vacancy in the office of
27	Governor and in the office of Lieutenant Governor, <del>the</del>
28	Secretary of State shall become Governor; or if the office of
29	Secretary of State be vacant, then the Attorney General shall
30	become Governor; <del>or</del> if the office of Attorney General <u>is</u> <del>be</del>
31	vacant, <del>then the Comptroller shall become Governor; or if the</del>

1	office of Comptroller be vacant, then the Chief Financial
2	<u>Officer</u> <del>Treasurer</del> shall become Governor; or if the office of
3	<u>Chief Financial Officer is</u> <del>Treasurer be</del> vacant, <del>then the</del>
4	Commissioner of Education shall become Governor; or if the
5	office of Commissioner of Education be vacant, then the
6	Commissioner of Agriculture shall become Governor. Except as
7	otherwise provided in this section with respect to an
8	appointed successor to the office of Lieutenant Governor, a
9	successor under this section shall serve for the remainder of
10	the term and shall receive all the rights, privileges, and
11	emoluments of the Governor. In case a vacancy <u>occurs</u> <del>shall</del>
12	$rac{\operatorname{occur}}{\operatorname{in}}$ in the office of Governor and provision is not made $\operatorname{\underline{in}}$
