Section 4. Subsection (5) of section 381.855, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsections (6), (7), and (8) are added to that section, to read:

381.855 Florida Center for Universal Research to Eradicate Disease.--

(5) There is established within the center an advisory council that shall meet at least annually.

(a) The council shall consist of one representative from a Florida not-for-profit institution engaged in basic and clinical biomedical research and education which receives more than \$10 million in annual grant funding from the National Institutes of Health, to be appointed by the Secretary of Health from a different institution each term, and ~~the members~~

 2 Any vacancy on the advisory council shall be filled in the  
 3 same manner as the original appointment.

4 (7) The advisory council shall meet at least annually,  
 5 but may meet as often as it deems necessary to carry out its  
 6 duties and responsibilities. The advisory council may take  
 7 official action by a majority vote of the members present at  
 8 any meeting at which a quorum is present.

9 (8) The Legislature may annually appropriate funds to  
 10 the Florida Center for Universal Research to Eradicate Disease  
 11 for operating costs.
