A bill to be entitled

An act relating to sexual predators; creating s. 794.075, F.S.; prohibiting a sexual predator from possessing prescription drugs for the purpose of treating erectile dysfunction; providing criminal penalties; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 794.075, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

794.075 Sexual predators; erectile dysfunction drugs.--

(1) A person may not possess a prescription drug, as defined in s. 499.003(25), for the purpose of treating erectile dysfunction if the person is designated as a sexual predator under s. 775.21.

(2) A person who violates subsection (1) for the first time commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. A person who violates subsection (1) a second or subsequent time commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2006.
