(3) The parent of each student in a participating 5 6 school shall be provided with a copy of program information 7 and a screening form to assist the parent in the identification of depression and suicidal tendencies and to 8 help initiate family discussions. 9 (4) By January 1, 2007, the district school board of 10 11 each participating county shall provide to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives a 12 report that includes an itemized list of program costs, an 13 evaluation of participating schools, an assessment of the 14 15 quality of the program components, an assessment of the safety of program implementation, an assessment of the burden on 16 school support staff after implementation of the program, an 17 assessment of the efficacy of the program, and recommendations 18 19 regarding program effects and outcomes. The information shall 20 be reported for the pilot program in the aggregate, for each 21 participating county, and for each participating school in each participating county. 22 Section 2. The sum of \$600,000 is appropriated from 23 2.4 the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Education for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be distributed to the Michael 25 Buonauro Foundation to implement the Signs of Suicide 26 Prevention Program as a pilot program for secondary schools in 27 Brevard, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties in accordance 28 29 with this act.
