Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1, lines 12-25, delete those lines

and insert:

Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 375.075, Florida
Statutes, is amended, and subsection (4) is added to that
section, to read:

375.075 Outdoor recreation; financial assistance to
local governments.--

(3) A local government may submit up to three ~~two~~
grant applications during each application period announced by
the department. However, a local government may not have more
than three active projects expending grant funds during any
state fiscal year. The maximum project grant for each project
application may not exceed \$500,000 ~~\$200,000~~ in state funds.

(4) The department shall adopt by rule a determination
of the appropriate incentive for encouraging the construction
of inclusive playgrounds. As used in this subsection, the term

1 "inclusive playground" means a playground that is a
 2 barrier-free environment designed for children of all
 3 abilities, including those with physical, developmental,
 4 cognitive, and sensory disabilities, to experience
 5 independent, self-directed play, each at his or her own
 6 highest level of ability, and includes play components and
 7 equipment that are accessible and engage children who have
 8 various motor impairments.
