recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment

On page 18, line 12, after the period

insert: The council shall review infrastructure standards for
cruise passenger terminals or other buildings in a
restricted-access area having a potential human occupancy of
50 persons or more to ensure that such standards provide
protection from the most probable and creditable terrorist
threat to human life by the use of like or similar standards
to those set forth in the United States Department of Defense
Minimum Antiterrorism Standard for Buildings, Unified
Facilities Criteria 4-010-0 or other similar building criteria
established for passenger terminals. The council also shall
identify state or federal funding sources that may be used to
finance the cost of potential infrastructure or operational
security measures to address such measures.
