A bill to be entitled

An act relating to protective injunctions;
amending s. 784.046, F.S.; providing standing
for a governmental employer to seek an
injunction for protection against repeat
violence on behalf of an employee; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section
784.046, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

784.046 Action by victim of repeat violence, sexual
violence, or dating violence for protective injunction; powers
and duties of court and clerk of court; filing and form of
petition; notice and hearing; temporary injunction; issuance;
statewide verification system; enforcement.--

(2) There is created a cause of action for an
injunction for protection in cases of repeat violence, there
is created a separate cause of action for an injunction for
protection in cases of dating violence, and there is created a
separate cause of action for an injunction for protection in
cases of sexual violence.

(a) Any person who is the victim of repeat violence,
~~or~~ the parent or legal guardian of any minor child who is
living at home and who seeks an injunction for protection
against repeat violence on behalf of the minor child, or any
governmental employer of any person who is the victim of
repeat violence in a public workplace who seeks an injunction
for protection against repeat violence on behalf of the
employee has standing in the circuit court to file a sworn

1 petition for an injunction for protection against repeat
2 violence.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
4 law.
