A bill to be entitled

An act relating to natural gas; providing that any commercial or residential construction constructed after a certain date must allow the choice of electric or natural gas power, if available; providing an effective date.

WHEREAS, natural gas is a proven source of power in this state and in the nation, and

WHEREAS, natural gas utilities have quantities of natural gas in storage, and

WHEREAS, natural gas is growing in popularity in the consumer market, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Effective October 1, 2006, any commercial or residential construction that is constructed in this state must allow the choice of electric or natural gas power, if available.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

SENATE SUMMARY
