The Committee on Transportation (Sebesta) recommended the following **amendment to amendment** (864152):

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 3, line 22, after the period

insert: Fifty percent of the moneys received from the enhanced fine imposed by this subsection shall be remitted to the Department of Revenue and deposited into the Department of Health Administrative Trust Fund to provide financial support to certified trauma centers to assure the availability and accessibility of trauma services throughout the state. Funds deposited into the Administrative Trust Fund under this section shall be allocated as follows:

(a) Fifty percent shall be allocated equally among all Level I, Level II, and pediatric trauma centers in recognition of readiness costs for maintaining trauma services.

(b) Fifty percent shall be allocated among Level I, Level II, and pediatric trauma centers based on each center's relative volume of trauma cases as reported in the Department of Health Trauma Registry. The remainder of the enhanced fine
