



1 develop and authorize a uniform firearms proficiency  
2 verification card to be issued to qualified law enforcement  
3 officers and qualified retired law enforcement officers who  
4 achieve a passing score on the firing range testing component  
5 of the minimum firearms proficiency course for active law  
6 enforcement officers, indicating the person's name and the  
7 date upon which he or she achieved the passing score. Each  
8 such card shall be issued only by range instructors certified  
9 by the commission.

10       (2) Facilities operating firing ranges on which range  
11 instructors certified by the commission administer the firing  
12 range testing component of the minimum firearms proficiency  
13 course for active law enforcement officers may open the firing  
14 range under terms and conditions established by the operating  
15 entity to other persons for purposes of allowing such persons  
16 to demonstrate their ability to achieve a passing score on the  
17 firing range testing component of the minimum firearms  
18 proficiency course. All costs associated with the  
19 demonstration by any such person that he or she meets the  
20 requirements of the firing range testing component of the  
21 minimum firearms proficiency course shall be at the expense of  
22 the person being tested.

23           Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
