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The Committee on Education Appropriations (Miller) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 138, between lines 22 and 23,

insert:

Section 63. Section 1003.425, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

1003.425 Required information for 9th-grade students.--Beginning in the 2007-2008 school year, each student who is in the second semester of the 9th grade in a public school must have been given instruction in:

(1) The value of a high school education, both financial and cultural;

(2) The alternative assessments, such as the SAT and the ACT, the scores of which could help the student obtain a high school diploma; and

(3) The postsecondary options that are available, including workforce training and enrolling in a community college or a university, and the prerequisites to each, with

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1 or without a diploma. The instruction must include a detailed
2 discussion of the relative advantages and disadvantages of
3 each alternative.
