Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 9, between lines 23 and 24,

insert:

Section 3. On or before October 1, 2006, the Department of Environmental Protection shall enter into negotiations with any local government within the Northwest Florida Water Management District that requests to be delegated the responsibilities under this act pursuant to s. 373.441, Florida Statutes, in order to minimize duplicative permitting programs and increase governmental efficiency while maintaining environmental standards. The department shall report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives by March 1, 2007, regarding progress made in the negotiation of environmental permitting with any local government and delegation of responsibilities thereto in accordance with this section.

Section 4. Section 4 of chapter 2005-273, Laws of Florida, and section 32 of chapter 2005-71, Laws of Florida,
