On page 3, line 15,

insert:

Section 1. Subsection (16) is added to section 627.732, Florida Statutes, to read:

627.732 Definitions.--As used in ss. 627.730-627.7405, the term:

(16) "Diagnostic testing facility" means a person, partnership, firm, or other business entity that performs the technical component of magnetic imaging, static radiographs, computer tomography, and positron emission tomography, and provides the professional component of the service through an employee or independent contractor in a fixed facility that is accredited by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations and the American College of Radiology within 1 year after licensure and:

(a) Does not accept referrals prohibited by s.
