Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 39, line 27, following the period

insert: If a court finds that an insurer has systematically caused annoyance, embarrassment, or oppression under the discovery provisions of this paragraph, the court may enter an order making such a finding against the insurer. Actions by an insurer which are the subject of such a finding constitute a violation of the insurance code.
