The instructional standards must include 4 the effect a dart-firing stun gun has on persons under the 5 influence of alcohol or drugs. б (3) Each basic-skills course required for 7 certification as a law enforcement, correctional, or 8 correctional probation officer must include instruction on the 9 use of dart-firing stun guns. The portion of the basic-skills 10 course on the use of stun guns must be a minimum of 4 hours' duration. 11 12 (4) After completing the basic-skills course, each law 13 enforcement, correctional, and correctional probation officer must complete an annual training course on the use of 14 dart-firing stun guns.
