A dental hygienist 10 11 may also perform dental charting on a volunteer basis at <u>health fairs.</u> 12 13 (3) Each person who receives a dental charting pursuant to this section, or the parent or legal quardian of 14 15 the person, shall receive and acknowledge a written disclosure form before receiving the dental charting procedure that 16 states that the purpose of the dental charting is to collect 17 data for use by a dentist at a prompt subsequent examination. 18 The disclosure form shall also emphasize that diagnosis of 19 20 caries, soft tissue disease, oral cancer, temporomandibular joint disease (TMJ), and dentofacial malocclusions can only be 21 22 completed by a dentist in the context of delivering a comprehensive dental examination. 23 2.4 (4) The board shall approve the content of charting and disclosure forms to be used under this section.
