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The Committee on Children and Families (Fasano) recommended
the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 4, line 27,

insert:

Section 1. Subsection (3) is added to section 383.335,
Florida Statutes, to read:

383.335 Partial exemptions.--

(3) Any facility that is located in trauma district
17, owned and operated by a board-certified obstetrician as of
June 15, 2006, and subject to licensure under ss.
383.30-383.335 is exempt from the prohibition against
providing conduction anesthesia contained in s. 383.313(3) for
3 years. The facility must be located within 1 mile of a
hospital that has a neonatal intensive care unit and must have
a written transfer agreement with such hospital. Within the
first 24 months of operation, the agency shall review the
safety and outcome data for patients served in order to
determine the viability of statewide application of the
