24	(b) <u>1.</u> Sealed bids or proposals received by an agency
25	pursuant to invitations to bid or requests for proposals are
26	exempt from s. $119.07(1)$ and s. $24(a)$ , Art. I of the State
27	Constitution until such time as the agency provides notice of
28	a decision or intended decision pursuant to s. 120.57(3)(a) or
29	within 10 days after bid or proposal opening, whichever is
30	earlier.
