27	species listed as endangered or threatened, including manatees

IV of the State Constitution, the commission has full constitutional 29 rulemaking authority over marine life, and listed species as 30 defined in s. 372.072(3), except for:

2	rulemaking shall be done pursuant to chapter 120; and

4	residential, manmade saltwater canals which is retained by the

8	apply to snook, prohibited and restricted marine species

16	(6) The Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission is
17	granted authority to adopt rules pursuant to s. 370.025
18	implementing this section and the prohibitions and
19	restrictions of s. 16, Art. X of the State Constitution.
20	Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
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
