13	Section 1. Subsection (5) of section 409.814, Florida
14	Statutes, is amended to read:
15	409.814 EligibilityA child who has not reached 19 years
16	of age whose family income is equal to or below 200 percent of
17	the federal poverty level is eligible for the Florida KidCare
18	program as provided in this section. For enrollment in the
19	Children's Medical Services Network, a complete application
20	includes the medical or behavioral health screening. If,
21	subsequently, an individual is determined to be ineligible for
22	coverage, he or she must immediately be disenrolled from the
23	respective Florida KidCare program component.
24	(5) A child whose family income is above 200 percent of
25	the federal poverty level or a child who is excluded under the
26	provisions of subsection (4) may participate in the <u>Medikids</u>
27	program as provided in s. 409.8132 or, if the child is

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28 <u>ineligible for Medikids by reason of age, in the Florida Healthy</u>
29 <u>Kids program</u> Florida KidCare program, excluding the Medicaid
30 program, but is subject to the following provisions:

(a) The family is not eligible for premium assistance
payments and must pay the full cost of the premium, including
any administrative costs.

(b) The agency is authorized to place limits on enrollment
in Medikids by these children in order to avoid adverse
selection. The number of children participating in Medikids
whose family income exceeds 200 percent of the federal poverty
level must not exceed 10 percent of total enrollees in the
Medikids program.

40 (C) The board of directors of the Florida Healthy Kids 41 Corporation is authorized to place limits on enrollment of these children in order to avoid adverse selection. In addition, the 42 43 board is authorized to offer a reduced benefit package to these 44 children in order to limit program costs for such families. The 45 number of children participating in the Florida Healthy Kids 46 program whose family income exceeds 200 percent of the federal 47 poverty level must not exceed 10 percent of total enrollees in 48 the Florida Healthy Kids program.

(d) Children described in this subsection are not counted
in the annual enrollment ceiling for the Florida KidCare
program.
