1	Section 2. The sum of \$535,000 is appropriated from
2	the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Health for the

8	Certification, and \$200,000 in nonrecurring revenue to the
9	Weston YMCA for special needs modifications and enhancement
10	for the developmentally disabled.
