30	Section 1. Section 1011.81, Florida Statutes, is

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1011.81 Community College Program Fund.--1 2 (1) There is established a Community College Program Fund. This fund shall comprise all appropriations made by the 3 Legislature for the support of the current operating program 4 and shall be apportioned and distributed to the community 5 college districts of the state on the basis of procedures б 7 established by law and rules of the State Board of Education. 8 The annual apportionment for each community college district 9 shall be distributed monthly in payments as nearly equal as possible. 10 (2) None of the funds made available in the Community 11 College Program Fund, or funds made available to community 12 13 colleges outside the Community College Program Fund, may be 14 used to implement, organize, direct, coordinate, or administer, or to support the implementation, organization, 15 direction, coordination, or administration of, activities 16 related to, or involving, travel to a terrorist state. For 17 18 purposes of this section, "terrorist state" is defined as any 19 state, country, or nation designated by the United States Department of State as a state sponsor of terrorism. 20 Section 2. Subsection (6) is added to section 1011.90, 21 22 Florida Statutes, to read: 23 1011.90 State university funding.--24 (6) None of the state or nonstate funds made available to state universities may be used to implement, organize, 25 direct, coordinate, or administer, or to support the 26 implementation, organization, direction, coordination, or 27 28 administration of, activities related to or involving travel 29 to a terrorist state. For purposes of this section, "terrorist state" is defined as any state, country, or nation designated 30 31

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by the United States Department of State as a state sponsor of 1 2 terrorism. 3 Section 3. Paragraphs (e), (f), and (g) of subsection 4 (3) of section 112.061, Florida Statutes, are redesignated as paragraphs (f), (g), and (h), respectively, and a new 5 paragraph (e) is added to that subsection to read: б 7 112.061 Per diem and travel expenses of public 8 officers, employees, and authorized persons .--9 (3) AUTHORITY TO INCUR TRAVEL EXPENSES.--(e) Travel expenses of public officers or employees 10 for the purpose of implementing, organizing, directing, 11 coordinating, or administering, or supporting the 12 13 implementation, organization, direction, coordination, or 14 administration of, activities related to or involving travel to a terrorist state shall not be allowed under any 15 circumstances. For purposes of this section, "terrorist state" 16 is defined as any state, country, or nation designated by the 17 18 United States Department of State as a state sponsor of 19 terrorism. Section 4. <u>No state funds made available to a private</u> 20 college or university in this state may be used to implement, 21 22 organize, direct, coordinate, or administer, or to support the implementation, organization, direction, coordination, or 23 24 administration of, activities related to, or involving, travel to a terrorist state. For purposes of this section, "terrorist 25 26 state" is defined as any state, country, or nation designated by the United States Department of State as a state sponsor of 27 28 terrorism. 29 Section 5.
