I of 2 the State Constitution. 3 4 (3) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand 5 repealed on October 2, 2011, unless reviewed and saved from б 7 repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. 8 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that the working papers, including all documentary 9 10 or other information, prepared or maintained by the Legislative Sunset Advisory Committee in performing its duties 11 12 under chapter 21, Florida Statutes, to conduct an evaluation 13 and prepare a report on whether to abolish a state agency and its advisory committees as defined in s. 21.002, Florida 14 Statutes, be made exempt from public records requirements. The 15 Legislature finds that the release of such information would 16 17 hinder the ability of the committee to conduct its evaluation 18 and prepare its report on whether to abolish a state agency and its advisory committees because employees and other 19 interested persons might be reluctant to provide information 2.0 21 knowing that the information would be public and could 2.2 potentially affect their employment or other dealings with the 23 agency under review. Protecting such information would help the committee complete a more thorough and reliable evaluation 2.4 and therefore make a better recommendation as to whether or 25 not to terminate a state agency and its advisory committees. 26 27 Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006, if 2.8 Senate Bill or similar legislation is adopted in the same 29 legislative session or an extension thereof and becomes law. 30 31
