A bill to be entitled  
An act relating to automated external  
defibrillators; requiring certain high schools  
to have a defibrillator on the school grounds;  
encouraging public and private partnerships to  
cover certain costs associated with  
defibrillators; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Each high school that is a member of the Florida High School Athletic Association shall have an operational defibrillator on the high school grounds. Public and private partnerships are encouraged to cover the cost associated with the purchase and placement of the defibrillator and training in the use of the defibrillator.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.

STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN  
COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR  
Senate Bill 248

The committee substitute requires each high school that is a member of the Florida High School Athletic Association to have an operational automated external defibrillator on the high school grounds. The bill encourages public/private partnerships to cover the cost associated with the training, purchase and placement of an automated external defibrillator.
