6 (3) Any person engaged in retrofitting, rebuilding, or
7 modifying commercial trucks, truck tractors, or heavy trucks,
8 as defined in s. 320.01, into dump trucks must ensure that
9 each retrofitted, rebuilt, or modified dump truck complies
10 with all federal safety standards provided in 49 C.F.R. s.
11 393.

12 (4) Any person who violates subsection (2) or
13 subsection (3) commits a misdemeanor of the second degree,
14 punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. Any person
15 who violates subsection (2) or subsection (3) a second time
16 commits a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as
17 provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. Any person who violates
18 subsection (2) or subsection (3) a third or subsequent time
19 commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided
20 in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084.

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2006.

25 Requires persons engaged in retrofitting, rebuilding, or
26 modifying commercial trucks, truck tractors, or heavy
27 trucks into dump trucks to have evidence of a commercial
28 liability insurance policy having minimum limits of \$1
29 million per accident and \$1 million annual aggregate.
30 Establishes safety standards for such trucks. Provides
31 penalties.
