basins. As part of the report the advisory council shall
include recommendations on the feasibility of an above ground
reservoir to to be constructed, operated, and maintained for
the storage of high level discharges from Lake Okeechobee to
the Caloosahatchee River. In developing the recommendations,
the advisory council shall consider infrastructure necessary
to transfer water being discharged from Lake Okeechobee to the
reservoir and infrastructure necessary to construct, operate,
and maintain water production and transmission facilities for
the purpose of supplying water for multiple uses to the
surrounding areas; and shall identify state and local water
resource development and water supply development programs
which encourage the development and use of alternative water
supplies through partnership efforts.
