The board shall transfer or cause to be transferred to the 58 59 institution designated by the qualified beneficiary an amount 60 not to exceed the redemption value of the advance payment 61 contract at a state postsecondary institution. If the cost of 62 registration or housing fees at such institution is less than 63 the corresponding fees at a state postsecondary institution, the amount transferred may not exceed the actual cost of 64 registration and housing fees. A transfer authorized under this 65 66 subsection may not exceed the number of semester credit hours or 67 semesters of dormitory residence contracted on behalf of a qualified beneficiary.
