Section 3. A pilot program for outsourcing driver license services is authorized in Indian River County and may be implemented by July 1, 2006. The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, upon request of the Indian River County Tax Collector, is directed to implement such outsourcing through the tax collector's office in Indian River County. Any necessary equipment shall also be provided by the department. Approvals of outsourcing to an outside entity shall be similar to approvals required of state-approved private automobile tag and registration entities. Service fees and services provided for any outsourcing shall be negotiated by the tax collector and the private entity. By February 1, 2007, the department and the tax
