**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

On page 5, between lines 15 and 16,

insert:

Section 3. (1) Before January 1, 2007, the Department of Environmental Protection must submit to the United States Department of Commerce the provisions of ss. 253.61, 377.06, 377.24, and 377.242, Florida Statutes, as substantial changes to the enforceable policies related to uses subject to the Florida Coastal Management Program as authorized under the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended, and pursuant to the process set forth in regulations at 15 C.F.R. s. 923.80, et seq.

(2) Any activities prohibited by the provisions of ss. 253.61, 377.06, 377.24, and 377.242, Florida Statutes, are inconsistent with the Florida Coastal Management Program, unless, because of changed circumstances or new information material to a consistency determination, the Governor and the Cabinet subsequently find upon clear and convincing evidence
