Cargo container inspections; study by the Department of Transportation. -- The Department of 14 Transportation is directed to conduct a comprehensive study of 15 current procedures for inspecting cargo containers at 16 17 airports, seaports, and railroad stations in this state. The 18 study shall include a review of the current inspection procedures, number of inspections relative to the total number 19 of cargo containers, equipment and technology used and 20 21 available for the inspections, and the costs of that equipment 22 and technology. The department shall report its findings to 23 the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives before July 1, 2007. The report 2.4 shall also include suggested methods to increase the number of 25 26 inspections to 100 percent of all cargo containers, equipment, 27 and technology available to improve and increase the number of 2.8 inspections, and funding sources to help defray the costs of improving and increasing the number of inspections. 29 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006. 31
