15	Section 1. Subsections (3) and (4) of section 1009.66,
16	Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

18	(3) Only loans to pay the costs of tuition, books, and
19	living expenses shall be covered, at an amount not to exceed
20	\$7,000 for each year of education toward the degree
21	obtained.
22	(4) From the funds available, the Department of Health
23	may make loan principal repayments of up to <u>\$7,000</u> \$4,000 a
24	year for up to 4 years on behalf of selected graduates of an
25	accredited or approved nursing program. All repayments shall
26	be contingent upon continued proof of employment in the
27	designated facilities in this state and shall be made directly
28	to the holder of the loan. The state <u>does not</u> <del>shall</del> bear <u>any</u>
29	<del>no</del> responsibility for the collection of any interest charges
