A bill to be entitled
An act relating to Broward County, Florida;
requiring the Property Appraiser of Broward
County to forward a copy of the findings of the
Florida Department of Revenue regarding the
Broward County Assessment Rolls to the Mayor of
Broward County, each county commissioner, and
the county auditor; providing an effective
date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. The Property Appraiser of Broward County shall, within 90 days after receipt of the findings of the Florida Department of Revenue regarding the Broward County Assessment Rolls, forward a copy of the findings to the Mayor of Broward County, each county commissioner, and the county auditor. The results furnished to the Mayor of Broward County, each county commissioner, and the county auditor shall include the same results as furnished to the county property appraiser, such as all statistical and analytical measures computed for the real property assessment roll as a whole, the personal property assessment roll as a whole, and, independently for the real property classes and subclasses studied, results of any audit or review of procedures used by the county property appraiser, and, if Broward County is not being studied in the current year, any value-weighted mean levels of assessment projected for that year pursuant to state law.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
