2	An act relating to Broward County; providing		
3	for extending the corporate limits of the Town		
4	of Davie; providing for annexation of the		
5	unincorporated area known as Broadview Park;

9	agreement; providing for a continuation of

14	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:		
15			
16	Section 1. <u>No later than September 1, 2006, the Town</u>		
17	of Davie and the Broward County Board of County Commissioners		
18	may enter into an interlocal agreement agreeing to the		
19	transition of the annexation of Broadview Park, as defined in		
20	section 3, into the Town of Davie.		
21	Section 2. If the Town of Davie and the Broward County		
22	Board of County Commissioners enter into the interlocal		
23	agreement as provided in section 1, the Broward County Board		
24	of County Commissioners shall schedule an election on November		
25	7, 2006, in accordance with the provisions of the law relating		
26	to elections currently in force in Broward County. The subject		
27	of said election shall be the annexation of the Broadview Park		
28	<u>Area. The voters residing in the Broadview Park Area shall, by</u>		
29	majority vote of the voters participating in the election,		
30	choose whether to be annexed by the Town of Davie on September		
31	15, 2008. A mail ballot shall not be used in this election.		

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1	However, voters may vote by absentee ballot as provided by	
2	law.	
3	Section 3. The Broadview Park Area is described as:

5	That portion of Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24,	
б	Township 50 South, Range 41 East and Section 18	
7	Township 50 South, Range 42 East, Broward	
8	County, Florida, described as follows:

10	Beginning at a point on the boundary of the

12	68-101 Laws of Florida, being the Southeast

19	thence continuing along the said boundary of	
20	the City of Plantation the following 6 courses;

22	thence Northeasterly along the East line of	
23	said Tier 24, to the North line of said Section	
24	<u>13;</u>

27	Section 13 to a point of intersection with the	
28	Northerly extension of the Westerly line of	
29	Block 3, as shown by the plat of LAUDERDALE	
30	HIGHLANDS as recorded in Plat Book 12, at Page

3	said Block 3 and its Northerly extension
4	thereof, to the Southwesterly corner of Lot 11

9	to a point of intersection with the Easterly
10	right-of-way line of Highland Avenue, as shown
11	by said plat of LAUDERDALE HIGHLANDS;

13	thence Southwesterly along the Easterly
14	right-of-way line of said Highland Avenue to a
15	point of intersection with the South line of
16	Block 1, as shown by said plat of LAUDERDALE
17	HIGHLANDS;

19	thence Easterly along the South line of said
20	Block 1 and its Easterly extension thereof to a
21	point of intersection with the East
22	right-of-way line of State Road No.7, as
23	described in City of Fort Lauderdale annexing
24	Resolution No. 8519;

26	thence Southerly along the said east
27	right-of-way line to the North right-of-way
28	line of Riverland Road and the boundary of the
29	Town of Davie as described in Chapter 84-420,

2	Town of Davie the following 10 courses;

4	thence Westerly along the Westerly prolongation
5	of the said North right-of-way line to the West
6	right-of-way line of State Road No.7;

10	feet North of the Southerly line of Tract 2,
11	Tier 4, of said Newman's Survey, as measured
12	along the said Westerly right-of-way line;

15	right-of-way line of Southwest 41st Avenue,
16	being 298.34 feet Northerly from the Southwest
17	corner of said Tract 2, Tier 4;

19	thence Westerly to a point of intersection of
20	the West right-of-way line of Southwest 41st
21	Avenue with the North line of said Section 24;

23	thence Southwesterly along the said West
24	right-of-way line to the centerline of North
25	New River Canal;

27	thence Southeasterly along said centerline to
28	the Westerly right-of-way line of State Road
29	<u>No.7;</u>

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1	thence Southwesterly along said West
2	right-of-line to the South bank of the North

5	thence Northwesterly along said South bank to
6	the Northerly extension of the West line of the
7	<u>East One-Half of Tract 1, Tier 7 of said</u>
8	<u>Newman's Survey;</u>

10	thence Southwesterly along said Northerly
11	extension to the Northwest corner of the said
12	<u>East One-Half of Tract 1, Tier 7, also being on</u>
13	the South right-of-way line of North New River
14	Canal;
15	
16	thence Northwesterly along the said Southerly
17	right-of-way line to the Easterly line of Tier
18	21 of said Newman's Survey;
19	
20	thence Northwesterly, continuing on the
21	boundary of the Town of Davie, along the said
22	Southerly right-of-way line to the intersection
23	with the Southwesterly extension of the East
24	line of the aforesaid Tract 1, Tier 24;
25	
26	thence Northeasterly along said Southwesterly
27	extension to the Point of Beginning.

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1	That portion of Sections 7, 8, 14, 15, 16 and
2	17, Township 50 South, Range 41 East
3	and Sections 2, 3, 11 and 12, Township 50
4	South, Range 40 East, Broward County, Florida,

7	Beginning at a point on the boundary of the
8	City of Plantation established by Chapter
9	68-101, Laws of Florida, being the Southeast
10	corner of Tract 1, Tier 24, according to
11	Newman's Survey of Section 14, Township 50
12	South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat Book
13	2, Page 26, Public Records of Dade County,
14	<u>Florida;</u>

16	thence Northwesterly along the North right of
17	way line of the North New River Canal and along
18	the boundary of the City of Plantation
19	established by said Chapter 68-101 and by

21	Section 4. <u>Upon annexation into the Town of Davie, the</u>
22	following shall govern the Broadview Park Area:
23	(1) The present land use designations and zoning
24	districts provided for under the Broward County Comprehensive
25	Plan and Code of Ordinances of Broward County shall remain in
26	the law governing the Broadview Park Area, notwithstanding the
27	fact that the Broadview Park Area is now a part of the Town of
28	Davie.
29	(2) Any change of zoning districts or land use
30	designations may only be accomplished by enactment of the vote
31	

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1 of the majority of the full governing body of the Town of 2 Davie plus one. (3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2), any use, 3 building, or structure that is legally in existence at the 4 5 time that the Broadview Park Area becomes a part of the Town б of Davie shall not be made a prohibited use by the 7 municipality, on the property of said use, for as long as the 8 use shall continue and not be voluntarily abandoned. 9 Section 5. Subsequent to the effective date of this 10 act, no change in land use designation or zoning shall be effective within the limits of the lands subject to annexation 11 12 herein until the Broadview Park Area has been annexed into the 13 Town of Davie. No annexation within the Broadview Park Area by any municipality shall occur during the time period between 14 the effective date of this act and the effective date of the 15 16 annexation. 17 Section 6. Subsequent to the effective date of this 18 annexation, any resident in the area to be annexed by this act 19 into the Town of Davie shall be deemed to have met any residency requirements for candidacy for municipal office. 20 21 Section 7. Nothing in this act shall be construed to 2.2 affect or abrogate the rights of parties to any contracts, 23 including contracts between nongovernmental entities, which contracts are in effect prior to the effective date of the 2.4 25 annexation. Section 8. All public roads and the public 26 27 rights-of-way associated therewith, on the Broward County Road 2.8 System, including bridge structures 868303, 864024, 864022, 864096, and 864097, lying within the limits of the Broadview 29 Park Area as described in section 3, are transferred from 30 Broward County jurisdiction to the jurisdiction of the 31

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1	annexing municipality, except for those portions of Hiatus
2	Road, Nob Hill Road, Pine Island Road, and Davie Boulevard and
3	that portion of Peters Road west of the Peters Road/Davie
4	Boulevard intersection lying within the annexation area. All
5	rights, title, interests, and responsibilities for any
6	transferred roads, including, but not limited to, the
7	ownership, operation, maintenance, planning, design, and
8	construction of said roads and to the rights-of-way associated
9	therewith shall transfer from Broward County jurisdiction and
10	ownership to the jurisdiction and ownership of the annexing
11	municipality upon the effective date of the annexation.
12	Section 9. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
13	law.
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
