943.1717 Use of dart-firing stun guns.--

- (1) A law enforcement, correctional, or correctional probation officer's decision to use a dart-firing stun gun must involve an arrest or a custodial situation during which the person who is the subject of the arrest or custody escalates resistance to the officer from passive physical resistance to active physical resistance and the person:
- (a) Has the apparent ability to physically threaten the officer or others; or
 - (b) Is preparing or attempting to flee or escape.
- The Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission shall establish standards for instructing law enforcement,

correctional, and correctional probation officers in the use of dart-firing stun guns in self-defense and in the use of deadly force. The instructional standards must include the effect a dart-firing stun gun has on persons who are under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

- (3) Each basic skills course required for certification as a law enforcement, correctional, or correctional probation officer must include instruction on the use of dart-firing stunguns. The portion of the basic skills course on the use of stunguns must be a minimum of 4 hours' duration.
- (4) After completing the basic skills course, each law enforcement, correctional, and correctional probation officer must complete an annual training course on the use of dartfiring stun guns. The annual training course on the use of stun guns must be a minimum of 1 hour duration.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
