Paragraph (f) of subsection (4) of section 1001.42, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 19 1001.42 Powers and duties of district school 20 board.--The district school board, acting as a board, shall 21 22 exercise all powers and perform all duties listed below: 23 (4) ESTABLISHMENT, ORGANIZATION, AND OPERATION OF 24 SCHOOLS.--Adopt and provide for the execution of plans for the establishment, organization, and operation of the schools of 25 the district, including, but not limited to, the following: 26 (f) Opening and closing of schools; fixing uniform 27 date.--Adopt policies for the opening and closing of schools 28 29 and fix uniform dates provided that the opening date of the school year for schools in the district shall be no earlier 30 31 than 14 days before Labor Day each year.

Subsection (2) of section 1011.60, Florida 1 2 Statutes, is amended to read: 3 1011.60 Minimum requirements of the Florida Education 4 Finance Program. -- Each district which participates in the state appropriations for the Florida Education Finance Program 5 shall provide evidence of its effort to maintain an adequate б 7 school program throughout the district and shall meet at least 8 the following requirements: 9 (2) MINIMUM TERM AND OPENING DATE. -- Operate all schools for a term of at least 180 actual teaching days or the 10 equivalent on an hourly basis as specified by rules of the 11 State Board of Education each school year provided that the 12 13 opening date of the term shall be no earlier than 14 days 14 before Labor Day each year. The State Board of Education may prescribe procedures for altering, and, upon written 15 application, may alter, this requirement during a national, 16 state, or local emergency as it may apply to an individual 17 18 school or schools in any district or districts if, in the opinion of the board, it is not feasible to make up lost days, 19 and the apportionment may, at the discretion of the 20 Commissioner of Education and if the board determines that the 21 reduction of school days is caused by the existence of a bona 2.2 23 fide emergency, be reduced for such district or districts in 24 proportion to the decrease in the length of term in any such school or schools. A strike, as defined in s. 447.203(6), by 25 employees of the school district may not be considered an 26 27 emergency. 28 Section 3. The amendments to ss. 1001.42(4)(f) and 29 1011.60(2), Florida Statutes, made by this act shall apply to school years beginning with the 2007-2008 school year unless a 30
