An act relating to sexual predators; amending s. 775.21, F.S.; redefining the terms "permanent residence" and "temporary residence" in order to reduce the number of consecutive days and days in the aggregate which constitute the residence of a sexual predator for purposes of requirements that the predator register with the Department of Law Enforcement, the sheriff's office, or the Department of Corrections; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraphs (f) and (g) of subsection (2) of section 775.21, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:
775.21 The Florida Sexual Predators Act.--
(2) DEFINITIONS.--As used in this section, the term:
(f) "Permanent residence" means a place where the person abides, lodges, or resides for $5 \underline{14}$ or more consecutive days.
(g) "Temporary residence" means a place where the person abides, lodges, or resides for a period of 514 or more days in the aggregate during any calendar year and which is not the person's permanent address; for a person whose permanent residence is not in this state, a place where the person is employed, practices a vocation, or is enrolled as a student for any period of time in this state; or a place where the person routinely abides, lodges, or resides for a period of 4 or more eonsecutive or nonconsecutive days in any month and which is not Page 1 of 2

the person's permanent residence, including any out-of-state address.
