14	Section 1. Assessment of obsolete agricultural							
15	equipment							
16	(1) For purposes of assessment for ad valorem property							
17	taxes, obsolete farm equipment shall be deemed to have a market							
18	value no greater than its market value for salvage. As used in							
19	this section, the term "agricultural equipment" means any							
20	equipment that qualifies for the sales tax exemption provided in							
21	s. 212.08(3), Florida Statutes. Agricultural equipment shall be							
22	considered obsolete for purposes of this section if it is no							
23	longer commonly used by the taxpayer.							
24	(2) Any taxpayer claiming the right of assessment for ad							
25	valorem taxes under the provisions of this section shall so							
26	state in a return filed as provided by law, giving a brief							
27	description of the equipment and its use. The property appraiser							
28	may require the taxpayer to produce any additional information
