Section 1. A government entity, in exercising the power of eminent domain otherwise conferred by law, may not take private property for the sole purpose of developing it for the benefit of a private party if no economic benefit is provided to the public. As used in this section, the term "government entity" means a state agency, political subdivision, or private corporation acting on behalf of a state agency or political subdivision.
