1 The State Infrastructure Council recommends the following:

8 to be revised to allow each applicant to make a voluntary

10 doing business as the Florida Heart Research Institute;
11 providing an effective date.

13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

15 Section 1. Subsection (16) of section 320.02, Florida
16 Statutes, is amended to read:

17 320.02 Registration required; application for
18 registration; forms.--

19 (16)(a) The application form for motor vehicle
20 registration shall include language permitting the voluntary
21 contribution of \$1 per applicant, to be quarterly distributed by
22 the department to Prevent Blindness Florida, a not-for-profit
23 organization, to prevent blindness and preserve the sight of the

24 residents of this state. A statement providing an explanation of
25 the purpose of the funds shall be included with the application
26 form. Prior to the department distributing the funds collected
27 pursuant to this paragraph, Prevent Blindness Florida must
28 submit a report to the department that identifies how such funds
29 were used during the preceding year.

30 (b) The application form for motor vehicle registration
31 and renewal of registration must include language permitting a
32 voluntary contribution to the Florida Mothers Against Drunk
33 Driving, Inc., which contribution must be transferred by the
34 department to the Florida Mothers Against Drunk Driving, Inc.,
35 on a monthly basis.

36 (c) The application form for motor vehicle registration
37 shall include language permitting the voluntary contribution of
38 \$1 per applicant, to be distributed quarterly by the department
39 to Southeastern Guide Dogs, Inc., a corporation not for profit
40 under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to be used by
41 that organization for the purpose of breeding, raising, and
42 training guide dogs for the blind. Such funds may also be used
43 toward the costs of the required in-residence training for the
44 individual receiving a guide dog.

45 (d) The application form for motor vehicle registration
46 shall include language permitting the voluntary contribution of
47 \$1 per applicant, to be distributed quarterly by the department
48 to the Miami Heart Research Institute, Inc., doing business as
49 the Florida Heart Research Institute, a corporation not for
50 profit under s. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, to be

51 | used by that organization for the purpose of heart-disease
52 | research, education, and prevention programs.

53 | (e) For the purpose of applying the service charge
54 | provided in s. 215.20, contributions received under this
55 | subsection are not income of a revenue nature.

56 | Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006.
