Florida Wild-Caught Food Shrimp Economic Development Trust Fund. --14 (1) There is created the Florida Wild-Caught Food 15 Shrimp Economic Development Trust Fund within the Fish and 16 Wildlife Conservation Commission. The purpose of the trust fund is to receive funds collected by the commission from the 18 annual fee imposed on individuals, firms, and corporations 19 engaged in the commercial taking of Florida wild-caught food 20 21 shrimp. Moneys in the trust fund shall be used for the purpose 22 of protecting and promoting markets for Florida wild-caught 23 food shrimp. (2) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the 2.4 State Constitution, the trust fund must, unless terminated 25 sooner, be terminated on July 1, 2010. Before its scheduled 26 27 termination, the trust fund must be reviewed as provided in s. 2.8 215.3206(1) and (2), Florida Statutes. Section 2. This act shall take effect on the effective 29 date of Senate Bill ____, or similar legislation, but it shall 30 31 not take effect unless it is enacted by a three-fifths vote of
