Registry.--

(5) The registrant may, at any time before ~~prior to~~
the birth of the child for whom paternity is claimed, execute
a notarized written revocation of the claim of paternity
previously filed with the Florida Putative Father Registry,
and upon receipt of such revocation, the claim of paternity
shall be deemed null and void. If a court determines that a
registrant is not the father of the minor or that his parental
rights have been terminated, the court shall order the
