16	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

18	Section 1. <u>No later than July 1, 2007, the school</u>
19	board of each public school district must adopt policies that
20	will ensure that the students in that school district are not
21	released from the schools to persons who are not authorized to
22	retrieve them. These policies must include a requirement that
23	a person attempting to retrieve the student present a picture
24	identification to the school principal or his or her designee
25	before the student is released to the person. As used in this
26	section, the term "picture identification" means a valid state
27	driver's license, a valid state identification card, a valid
28	<u>United States military identification card, a valid student</u>
29	<u>identification card from a postsecondary institution, or a</u>
30	valid employee identification card. Copies of the policies
31	must be provided to the Department of Education.
