(14) APPLICABILITY TO COUNTIES, COUNTY OFFICERS,
DISTRICT SCHOOL BOARDS, ~~AND~~ SPECIAL DISTRICTS, COMMUNITY
COLLEGE DISTRICTS, AND STATE UNIVERSITIES.--

(a) The following entities may establish rates that vary from the per diem rate provided in paragraph (6)(a), the subsistence rates provided in paragraph (6)(b), or the mileage rate provided in paragraph (7)(d) if those rates are not less than the statutorily established rates that are in effect for the 2005-2006 fiscal year ~~Rates that exceed the maximum travel reimbursement rates for nonstate travelers specified in paragraph (6)(a) for per diem, in paragraph (6)(b) for subsistence, and in subparagraph (7)(d)1. for mileage may be established by:~~

1. The governing body of a county by the enactment of

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1 an ordinance or resolution;

2 2. A county constitutional officer, pursuant to s.
3 1(d), Art. VIII of the State Constitution, by the
4 establishment of written policy;

5 3. The governing body of a district school board by
6 the adoption of rules; ~~or~~

7 4. The governing body of a special district, as
8 defined in s. 189.403(1), except those special districts that
9 are subject to s. 166.021(10), by the enactment of a
10 resolution;-

11 5. The district board of trustees of a community
12 college by the adoption of rules; or

13 6. The board of trustees of a state university by the
14 adoption of rules.

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
