and insert:

(5) District school boards may ~~shall~~ not establish
requirements for accelerated 3-year high school graduation
options in excess of the requirements in paragraphs (1)(b) and
(c).

(6) Students pursuing accelerated 3-year high school
graduation options pursuant to paragraph (1)(b) or paragraph
(1)(c) are required to:

(a) Earn passing scores on the FCAT as defined in s.
1008.22(3)(c) or scores on a standardized test that are
concordant with passing scores on the FCAT as defined in s.
1008.22(9).

(b)1. Achieve a cumulative ~~weighted~~ grade point
average of 3.5 ~~3.0~~ on a 4.0 scale, or its equivalent, in the
