Subsections (2), (3), and (4) of section 1 13 of chapter 2003-287, Laws of Florida, are amended to read: Section 1. 14 (2) Members of the council shall consist of  $\frac{14}{12}$ 15 voting members with  $\frac{7}{6}$  appointed by the President of the 16 17 Senate and  $\underline{7}$  6 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The council shall consist of representatives 18 as follows: 19 20 (a) <u>Two</u> A waterfront property <u>owners</u> <del>owner</del> from each 21 county, one of whom must be a property owner from the east side of the county and one of whom must be a property owner 22 23 from the west side of the county. (b) An attorney from each county. 2.4 (c) A member of the Board of Directors of the Chamber 25 of Commerce from each county. 26 (d) An environmental engineer from each county. 27 2.8 (e) An engineer from each county. 29 (f) A person from each county with training in biology or another scientific discipline. 30 31

1 (3) The council members from each county are to form 2 two separate county task forces from the council to review and make recommendations on specific waterways. The Hernando 3 4 County Task Force shall develop plans for the restoration of the waterways in Hernando County Weeki Wachee River and 5 б Springs. The Citrus County Task Force shall develop plans for 7 the restoration of the waterways in Citrus County Tsala Apopka 8 Chain of Lakes. 9 (4) There shall be a technical advisory group to the council and the two county task forces which shall consist of 10 one representative each from the Southwest Florida Water 11 12 Management District, the Department of Environmental 13 Protection, the Department of Transportation, the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, the Coastal Rivers Basin 14 Board, the Withlacoochee River Basin Board, the public works 15 department of each county, and the United States Army Corps of 16 17 Engineers, each of whom shall be appointed by his or her 18 respective agency and each of whom, with the exception of the representatives from the Withlacoochee River Basin Board and 19 Coastal Rivers Basin Board, shall have had training in biology 2.0 21 or another scientific discipline. 22 Section 2.
