Section 1. Subsection (10) of section 402.33, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

402.33 Department authority to charge fees for services provided.--

~~(10) (a) Unless otherwise specified by the Legislature, fee collections, including third party reimbursements, in excess of fee supported appropriations may be used in conformance with the provisions of chapter 216 to fund nonrecurring expenditures for direct client services and to fund administrative costs of improving the fee collection program of the department. No more than one sixth of the amount of collections in excess of the amount of appropriations may be used to fund such improvements to the program. Priority consideration for the expenditure of~~
