394.932 Registry of experts. -- The Justice Administrative 30 Commission shall maintain a registry of mental health and other 31 32 experts who are available and willing to provide examinations 33 and expert testimony in proceedings held under this part. The commission shall advertise the registry in professional trade 34 35 publications on a periodic basis and shall list the name and 36 contact information for all persons holding themselves out to be 37 qualified to provide examinations and expert testimony pursuant 38 to this part upon request. It shall be the sole responsibility 39 of parties using the services of a person listed on the registry to verify the qualifications of that person.
