I of the State 2.4 25 Constitution, except as otherwise provided by law. Such 26 information may be contained in records created by or received 27 by the department or its service providers or obtained through 2.8 files, reports, inspections, or otherwise by employees of the 29 department, persons who volunteer services through programs administered by the department or its contract providers, or 30 by contract providers.
