7 amending s. 464.0195, F.S.; requiring the Board of Nursing  
8 to incorporate specified data as a part of certain  
9 licensure and licensure renewal; amending s. 464.0196,  
10 F.S.; revising membership and term-limit criteria for the  
11 center's board of directors; providing an effective date.

13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

14  
15 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section  
16 464.0195, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

17 464.0195 Florida Center for Nursing; goals.--

18 (2) The primary goals for the center shall be to:

19 (a) Develop a strategic statewide plan for nursing  
20 manpower in this state by:

21 1. Establishing and maintaining a database on nursing  
22 supply and demand in the state, to include current supply and  
23 demand, and future projections. The Board of Nursing shall

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24 incorporate the collection of workforce planning data as part of  
 25 each advanced registered nurse practitioner, registered nurse,  
 26 and licensed practical nurse application for licensure and  
 27 biennial licensure renewal. Data shall be submitted to the  
 28 center for analysis and workforce planning; and

29 2. Selecting from the plan priorities to be addressed.

30 Section 2. Subsections (1) and (2) of section 464.0196,  
 31 Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

32 464.0196 Florida Center for Nursing; board of directors.--

33 (1) The Florida Center for Nursing shall be governed by a  
 34 policy-setting board of directors. The board shall consist of 16  
 35 members, with a simple majority of the board being nurses  
 36 representative of various practice areas. Other members shall  
 37 include representatives of other health care professions,  
 38 business and industry, health care providers, and consumers. The  
 39 members of the board shall be appointed by the Governor as  
 40 follows:

41 (a) One member recommended by the Florida Organization of  
 42 Nurse Executives shall be a registered nurse. ~~Four members~~  
 43 ~~recommended by the President of the Senate, at least one of whom~~  
 44 ~~shall be a registered nurse recommended by the Florida~~  
 45 ~~Organization of Nurse Executives and at least one other~~  
 46 ~~representative of the hospital industry recommended by the~~  
 47 ~~Florida Hospital Association;~~

48 (b) One member recommended by the Florida Hospital  
 49 Association shall be a representative of the hospital industry.  
 50 ~~Four members recommended by the Speaker of the House of~~  
 51 ~~Representatives, at least one of whom shall be a registered~~

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52 ~~nurse recommended by the Florida Nurses Association and at least~~  
53 ~~one other representative of the long term care industry;~~

54 (c) One member recommended by the Florida Nurses  
55 Association shall be a registered nurse. ~~Four members~~  
56 ~~recommended by the Governor, two of whom shall be registered~~  
57 ~~nurses; and~~

58 (d) One member jointly recommended by the Florida Health  
59 Care Association and the Florida Association of Homes for the  
60 Aging shall be a representative of the long-term care industry  
61 ~~Four nurse educators recommended by the State Board of~~  
62 ~~Education, one of whom shall be a dean of a College of Nursing~~  
63 ~~at a state university, one other shall be a director of a~~  
64 ~~nursing program in a state community college.~~

65 (e) One member recommended by the Florida Association of  
66 Colleges of Nursing shall be a dean of a college of nursing.

67 (f) One member recommended by the Florida Council of  
68 Nursing Education Administrators shall be a director of a  
69 nursing program in a community college.

70 (g) Two members recommended by the Speaker of the House of  
71 Representatives.

72 (h) Two members recommended by the President of the  
73 Senate.

74 (i) Two members recommended by the Commissioner of  
75 Education shall be nurse educators.

76 (j) Four members recommended by the Governor, two of whom  
77 shall be registered nurses and one of whom shall be a certified  
78 registered nurse anesthetist.

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79           (2) Beginning July 1, 2006, each current member of the  
80 board shall be replaced with a new member upon the expiration of  
81 his or her term. The terms of all members appointed on or after  
82 July 1, 2006, shall be for 3 years, and no such member may serve  
83 more than two consecutive terms. Current members who have served  
84 only one term may be appointed for a final 3-year term. The  
85 initial terms of the members shall be as follows:

86           ~~(a) Of the members appointed pursuant to paragraph (1) (a),~~  
87 ~~two shall be appointed for terms expiring June 30, 2005, one for~~  
88 ~~a term expiring June 30, 2004, and one for a term expiring June~~  
89 ~~30, 2003.~~

90           ~~(b) Of the members appointed pursuant to paragraph (1) (b),~~  
91 ~~one shall be appointed for a term expiring June 30, 2005, two~~  
92 ~~for terms expiring June 30, 2004, and one for a term expiring~~  
93 ~~June 20, 2003.~~

94           ~~(c) Of the members appointed pursuant to paragraph (1) (c),~~  
95 ~~one shall be appointed for a term expiring June 30, 2005, one~~  
96 ~~for a term expiring June 30, 2004, and two for terms expiring~~  
97 ~~June 30, 2003.~~

98           ~~(d) Of the members appointed pursuant to paragraph (1) (d),~~  
99 ~~the terms of two members recommended by the State Board of~~  
100 ~~Education shall expire June 30, 2005; the term of the member who~~  
101 ~~is a dean of a College of Nursing at a state university shall~~  
102 ~~expire June 30, 2004; and the term of the member who is a~~  
103 ~~director of a state community college nursing program shall~~  
104 ~~expire June 30, 2003.~~

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106 | ~~After the initial appointments expire, the terms of all the~~  
107 | ~~members shall be for 3 years, with no member serving more than~~
